## MIDDLE SCHOOL SPORTS PROGRAM PARENT AND PLAYER AGREEMENT

1. Behavior Expectations: Spectators, coaches, parents, and students are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship. All students will respect other people and their property, never endangering the welfare of another student, leader or themselves. Parent/guardian will be contacted if the student is involved in any hitting, kicking, physical or verbal abuse; uses inappropriate language, references to drugs, damages or steals property; is defiant towards authority; throws unauthorized objects; interferes with the rights or safety of others. The use of personal cell phones is prohibited during MSSP practices and games. Failure to comply with these behavioral expectations and the City of Golden/Skyhawks Sports Code of Conduct will result in a suspension or removal from the program.
2. Students may be released early from class for games and tournaments with school permission.
3. Students must dress appropriately for practice and **must wear their MSSP T-shirt for games.**
4. If they do not have their MSSP T-shirt they may not play. Neither the City of Golden nor Skyhawks Sports have extra T-shirts for players to borrow. Students may not share MSSP shirts during a game. Students will not be allowed to write on or alter their T-shirts in any way. Any shirts that are altered will have to be replaced at the participant's expense of \$10.
5. Students are responsible for their own belongings. Students should not ask another student or coach to "hold on to" valuable items. Neither the City of Golden nor Skyhawks Sports are responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. Please leave valuables at home.
6. Bus/van transportation is provided to away games whenever possible. Behavioral expectations will be enforced on all bus and van trips.
7. INJURY: In the case of a head injury or any serious bodily injury (i.e. sprains) during practice or games, the student will not be allowed to play for the remainder of the game and parents will be notified ASAP. All injuries in which parents were notified will require a doctor's note or parent release note before returning to practice.
8. Attendance at practice and games are mandatory. Parents, please notify the coach if your child will be unable to attend. Students must sign in for practice upon arrival.
9. HAVE FUN! This is a recreational league for those learning the game.
