

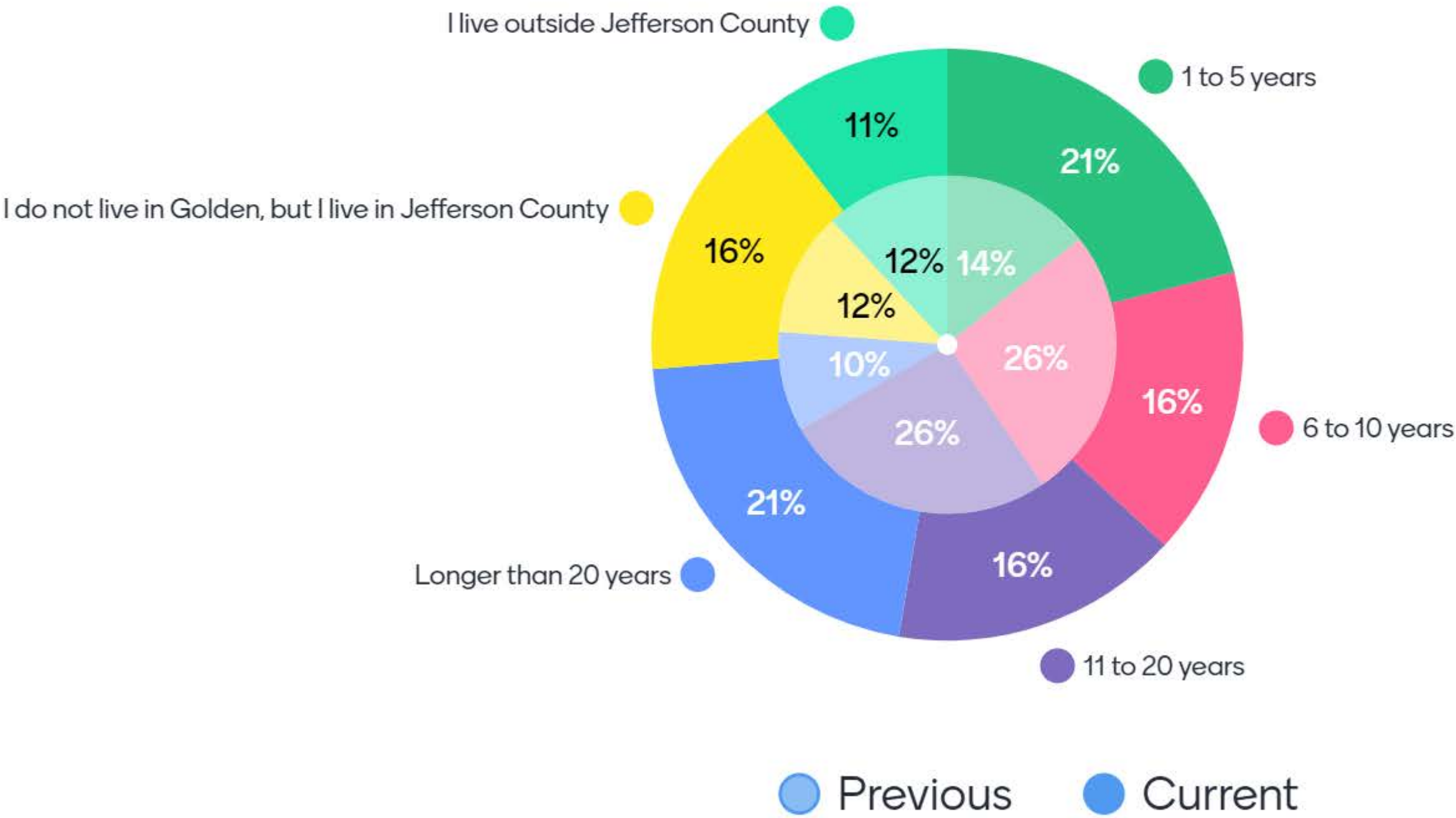

How long have you lived in Golden?



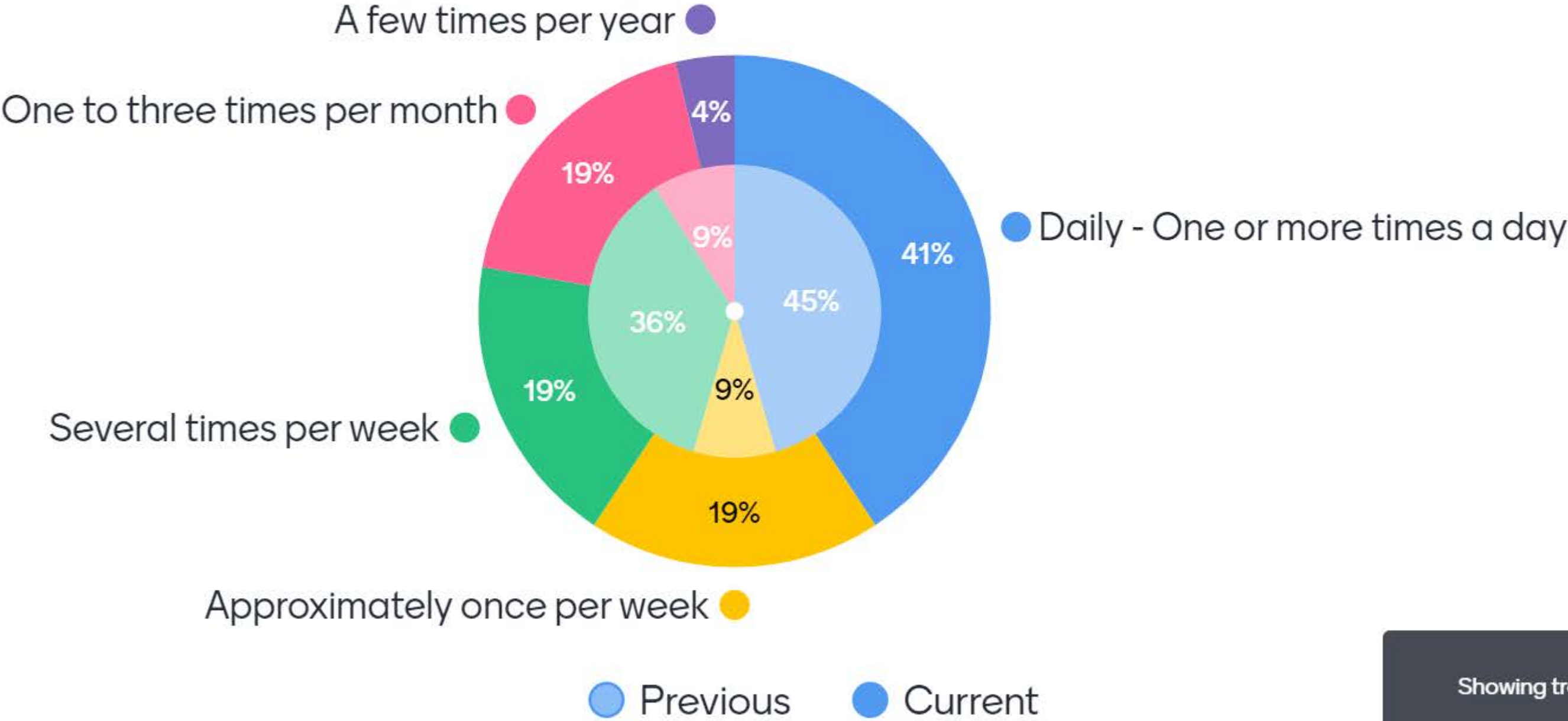

If you do live in Golden, what neighborhood do you live in?



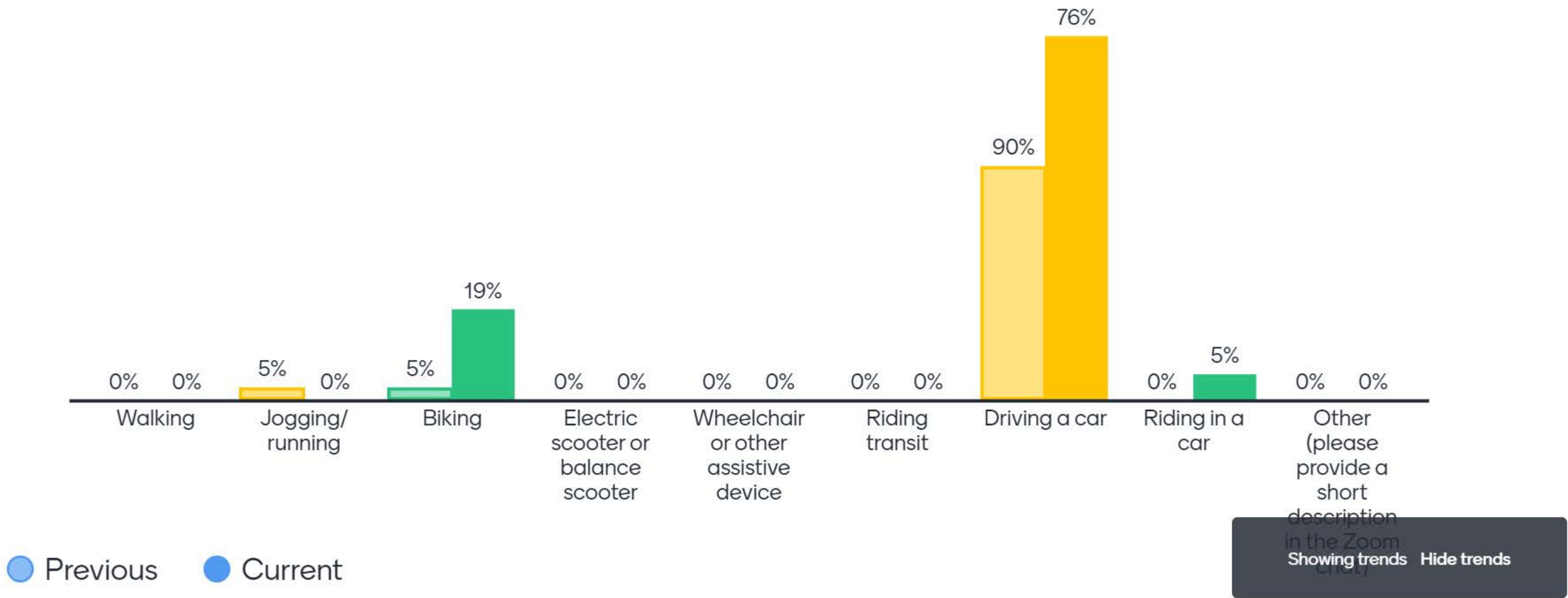

What are the issues and challenges associated with the US 6 and Heritage Road Interchange that the project needs to address?

Busy road. Not bike friendly. Left turns from Heritage have poor targets along Hwy 6. Surface intersections below curb hard to navigate on a bike, especially with trailer--too narrow

Safety. Bike and Ped accessibility. Capacity for cars.

Poor and possibly dangerous cyclist and pedestrian experience.

Long lines of vehicles trying to get through the intersection. Long signal times.

Pedestrian / bike mobility. Thru traffic mobility. Build without many impacts to traffic.

Traffic, wait times at light, not pedestrian or bike friendly, wildlife trap

Great question. Other than rush hour traffic in the late afternoon coming from 19th Ave I'm not aware of any problems that justify this project.

Noise and amount of traffic

It could be more bicycle/pedestrian friendly.

Lack of clear bike lane up to and through the intersection.

Dangerous to pedestrians

Need to have smooth transition from Hyw 6 and 93 to C470.
Completion of the 470 circle around Denver

Bike lane through and all the way across the intersection is needed for safety.

Not backing up the at-grade intersection at Johnson Road and US-6 to the point where the off-ramp to C-470 is blocked. This already happens at high-traffic periods, and will only get worse without mitigation (e.g. an aux lane b/w heritage and c470)

long delays on US 6

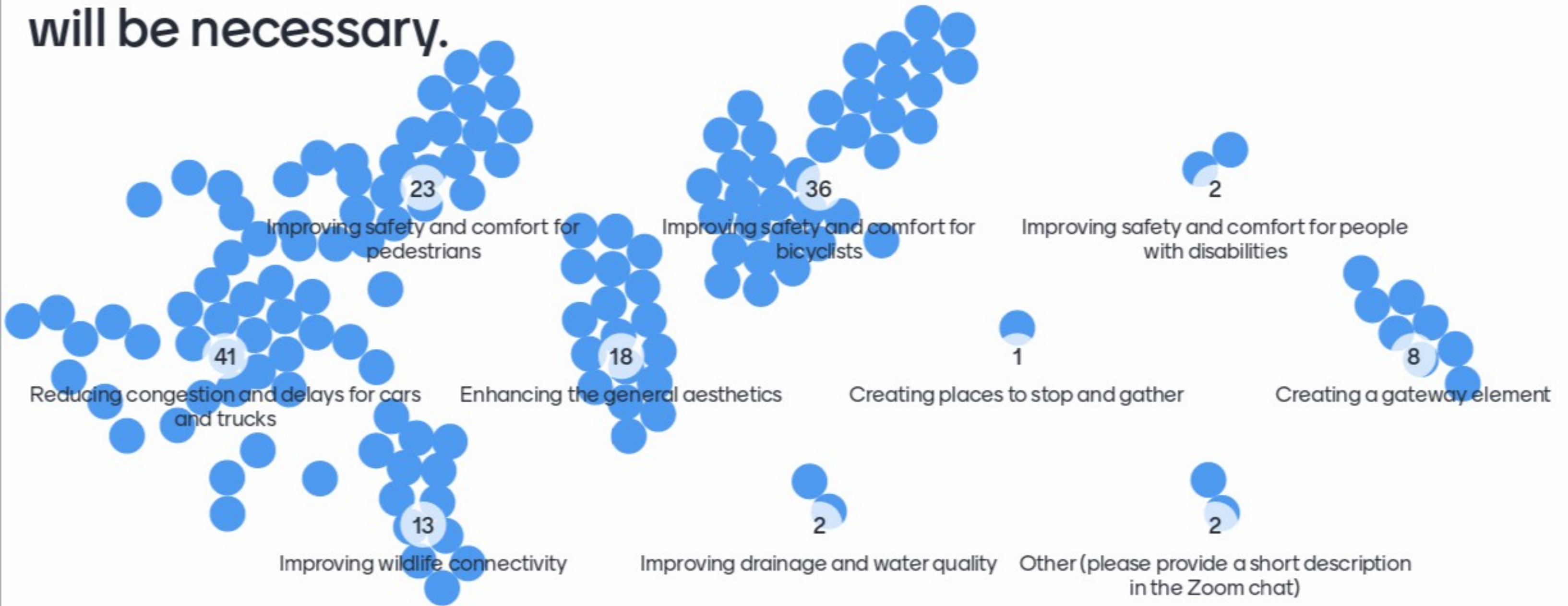
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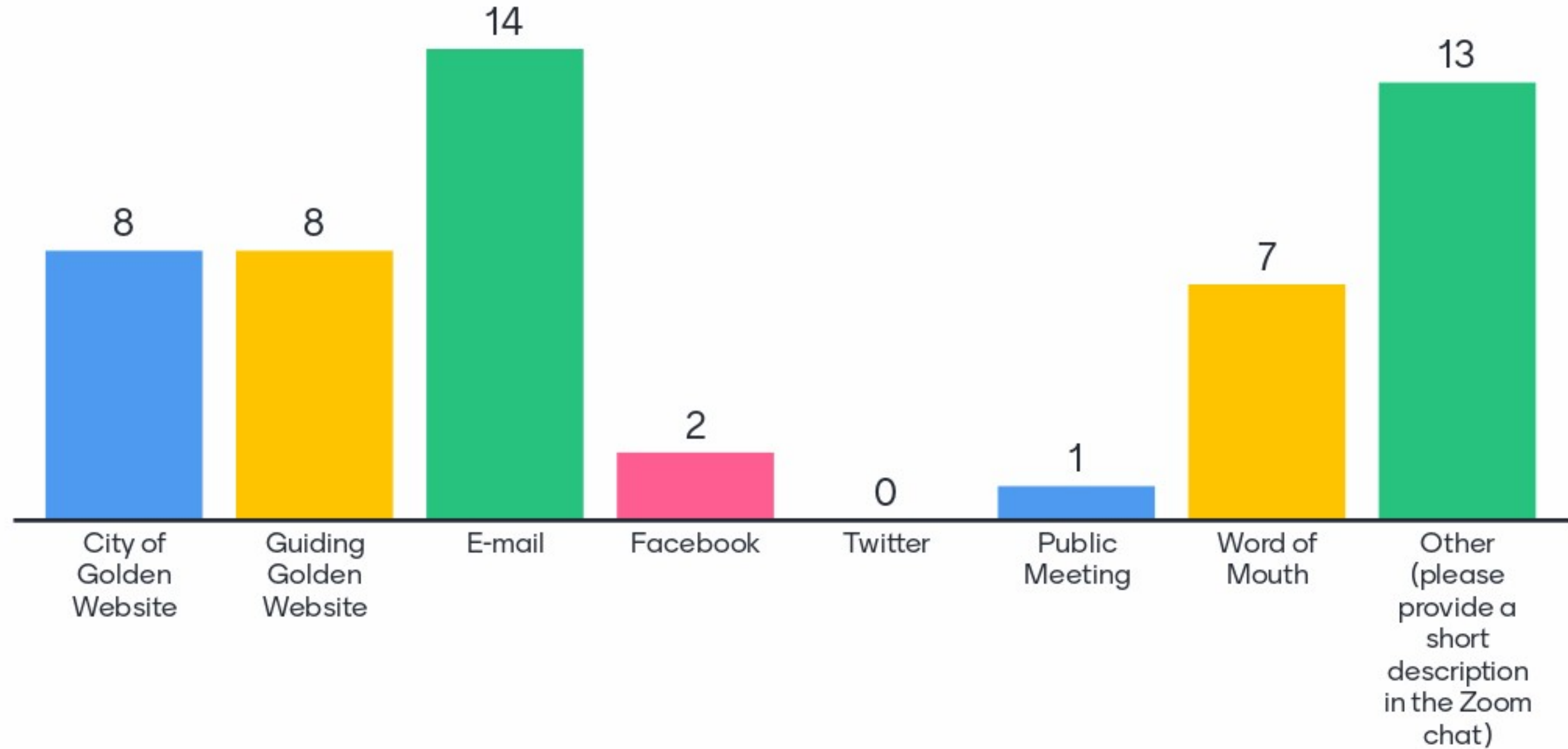
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While the goal is to address and balance as many opportunities as possible with the design for the intersection, some trade-offs will be necessary.
