

COURT ENTRY RULES

If you do not process your ticket electronically and you come to court the following procedures will be strictly enforced:

1. The flow of citizens in and out of the building may be controlled by a Golden Police officer working in conjunction with Court Staff.
2. If you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, you should not come to court. In that event you shall promptly contact the Court's Clerk by phone to reschedule your court date.
3. No more than five (5) members of the public will be allowed into the courtroom at any one time. If you are represented by an attorney, the attorney may accompany you. The attorney will count toward the (5) person limit in the courtroom. Parties are encouraged to avoid bringing others to court.
4. Face masks/coverings are to be properly worn by individuals in the building or waiting to enter the building.
5. Social distancing is to be respected. All must maintain a minimum of six (6) feet between yourself and all other persons.
6. If you are waiting to pay fines/fees, please also observe social distancing while waiting. Citizens are also encouraged to pay fines/fees online at www.municipalonlinepayments.com/goldenco.

The court adopts these reasonable measures as they are recommended by various health and safety experts. The health and safety of all is the responsibility of all.
