Dear parents of our super dancers,

We understand that you are wondering what is going to happen with dance during the fall year of 2020-2021. We are planning on moving forward with some guidelines to keep all our families and staff safe and healthy. Register now online at <https://rec.cityofgolden.net> under "Dance".

Please take note of the following changes to our policies and procedures during this pandemic:

Class

- For those of you who feel safer taking the classes online, we will have that option for you.
- Online classes will be viewed and participation will occur during the live class.
- There will not be childcare for siblings and only *one* other member of the household may attend to watch your dancer.
- The *one* guardian to observe, please bring a camping chair to set up in the class (to help with limiting our disinfecting of chairs).
- Unfortunately we will not offer singing lessons this fall.
- We will not be able have a show at the end of the year.
- Dances will be coordinated according to the 6 feet apart guideline.
- There is a minimum of 10 kids allowed to register for one class. One guardian will be able to attend and watch with the other parents as long as everyone maintains social distancing and face mask guidelines.

Check-In and Pick-Up

- Entrance and exit is on the community centers 8th street lot, you will have to follow the signs to class.
- Every participant will have on their registration receipt the understanding of being healthy and keeping our community healthy.
- There will be no access to the community center through the dance entrance and exit.
- Children and parents are respectfully asked to arrive and leave on time in order for proper cleaning and disinfecting.

Healthy Environment

- Children, guardians and staff will be required to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer immediately upon entering the building, and upon leaving.
- Staff will disinfect high-touch surfaces, such as door handles, light switches, faucets, Barres, and tap boards.
- There will be adequate supplies for the number of children in each group to minimize sharing of materials.
- There will be no mixing of groups or classrooms or supplies.
- Face masks are taught for all children to wear when social distancing of six feet between individuals are not being met, as well as the use of face masks indoors.

Child Health

- Staff will receive education on COVID-19 symptoms as well as preventative measures.
- Children who start to experience symptoms of illness, including a fever of 100.4°F or greater while at the center, will be required to leave class and the community center immediately.

Staff Health & Wellness

- Staff has received additional training on infection control and workplace disinfection.
- Staff who start to experience symptoms of illness, including a fever of 100.4°F or greater while working, will be sent home immediately and class will be rescheduled or cancelled with a refund for that class.
- Staff will not be allowed to work if they are feeling ill, experiencing any illness symptoms or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.
- Staff must wear face masks throughout the class and when social distancing of six feet between individuals cannot be achieved.

We have been working closely with Jefferson County Public Health Department and CDC guidance surrounding these measures. We truly want to keep our kids dancing, healthy and happy!

Please contact us with any questions or concerns. We are looking forward to seeing your children again and bringing back some routine and normalcy to their lives.
