- 8. Water may only be drawn from the assigned fire hydrant.
- 9. During operation only the throttle shall be used for volume control. The fire hydrant shall not be throttled but used only in the full open or fully closed position.
- 10. The applicant must comply with all applicable City of Golden and AWWA Water Specifications, including back flow prevention and cross connection standards.
- 11. City of Golden Fire Department Requirements include:
 - a) Hydrant permitted for use shall remain accessible for Fire Department use at all times. A minimum of a three foot clearance shall be maintained.
 - b) Water meter is to be removed when not in immediate use (i.e. daily) and hydrant appropriately drained after each use.
