

What is allowed in Stage 1 Fire Restrictions?

- Charcoal grill fires at a private residence or within a permanently constructed grate in a developed park, campground, or picnic area, and no closer than 30' from an undeveloped area.



- Any fires contained within liquid fueled or gas fueled stoves, lanterns or heating devices.



- Fire pits that are constructed with a permanent fire grate within a developed campground, picnic ground or recreation site, and are no closer than 30' from an undeveloped area.



- Tiki torches, portable fire pits, and chimineas' which are no closer than 30' from an undeveloped area.



What is not allowed under Stage 1 Fire Restrictions?

- Any fire or campfire, not within a permanently constructed fire grate in a developed park, campground, private residence, or picnic area.



- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area of at least six feet diameter that is barren or cleared of all combustible material.



- Sky Lanterns: Any uninhabited free floating device which includes a flame or other heating device to heat air as a lifting mechanism.
