

City of Golden REDI Task Force Application

The City of Golden seeks applicants to serve on a Task Force focused on advancing racial equity. The Race, Equity, Diversity & Inclusion (REDI) Task Force will be tasked with creating an implementation plan for year one of the City's REDI plan, researching REDI Task Force best practices in other cities, and a training plan for the task force, the community, and city staff. The Task Force provides updates to the REDI subcommittee and City Council and will report recommendations, including ways in which success will be measured toward becoming a more inclusive and responsive community. Members will be expected to serve for at least one year.

Time commitment: Task Force members are expected to attend one 60-90 minute meeting per month in addition to an average of 1-5 hours per month of outside work. We plan on working with the Task Force to determine the best time for the meeting and we will assist with addressing barriers to participation that may exist.

Requirements

To qualify as a member of the REDI Task Force you must be a Golden resident, work for the City of Golden, or have a connection to the City of Golden. Members should be able to participate in meetings which will be available in a hybrid manner (both in-person and virtual).

Selection Process

The Task Force is seeking up to 10 new members, which may include both community members and City of Golden employees. Applications will be reviewed by the REDI Subcommittee.

Applicant Information

All identifying information (including names, addresses and emails) will be redacted from all applications prior to the selection process. All questions must be answered, and all fields must be filled in.
