A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO JOIN THE COLORADO COMMUNITIES FOR CLIMATE ACTION GROUP

WHEREAS, the City of Golden recognizes the ongoing challenge of climate change and is committed to responsible energy policy and resource conservation through the adopted goals and targets within the Golden Sustainability Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Communities for Climate Action has been established to further the adoption of federal and state policies that will provide Colorado's local governments with the tools, funding, flexibility, and authority necessary to adopt effective climate protection strategies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden desires to support regional cooperation through participation in the early development of statewide and utility energy policies; and

WHEREAS, the Community Sustainability Advisory Board voted to unanimously support joining the group on February 24, 2016 for reasons of effectively advocating for local interests between the city and its utility providers, including negotiation of energy efficient street lighting, incentivizing demand-side management and increasing investment in local solar development.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

The City of Golden Colorado will join the Colorado Communities for Climate Action with a base annual membership for a period not to exceed three years and pledges to take a leadership role in promoting effective climate protection strategies.
