A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY REGARDING COVID-19

WHEREAS, the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. Section24-33.5-701, et seq. (the "Act"), provides procedures for statewide and local prevention or, preparation for, response to, and recovery from disasters and emergencies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the City Manager signed a Declaration of Local Emergency in and for the City of Golden related to the COVID-19 public health emergency on March 17th at 4:00 p.m. local time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Declaration of Local Emergency is valid for a period of seven (7) days unless rescinded or extended by the Golden City Council prior to expiration; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Declaration of Local Emergency signed on March 17, 2020, and has determined that the local emergency caused by the COVID-19 epidemic has not ceased.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO THAT:

- 1. The City Council hereby extends the Declaration of Local Emergency indefinitely until such time that City Council determines that the current public health emergency has ceased.
- 2. The City Council directs the City Clerk to publish and disseminate the extension of the Declaration of Local Emergency to the public, including but not limited to on the City's website and to the local news media;
- 3. The City Council directs the City Clerk to file a copy of this Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency with the City Clerk, and direct the City Clerk to immediately file copies of this Declaration with the Jefferson County Office of Emergency Management and the State of Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
