Project Name:	Rooney Road Sports Complex - Drainage and Turf Improvements
	A drainage study has been completed. A significant portion of the drainage infrastructure can be accomplished by the City of Golden. The final portion of drainage will need to be addressed when the turf is replaced as the fields will need to be graded. At this time, it is uncertain if this can be accomplished given the landfill that is below the fields. Internal improvements will include the following: creating several drainage channels, erosion prevention efforts and culvert repairs. Turf replacement will then be required on the five fields. The existing turf will have met it's useful life and will reach a point where it will be unsafe to continue play. A turf assessment completed in summer 2017 showed that the turf that was installed was originally tufted as a 2.25" fiber and now is approximately 1.25" around the perimeter and closer to only 1" in the middle of the fields. The contractor's report indicated that the most glaring concern in the complex is the amount of mud and debris that has washed onto the fields. Staff will begin the process of getting a more formalized quote.
