Your request for construction water use, for the above referenced hydrant number, is approved subject to the following conditions:

1) The Applicant agrees:

- a) To provide a \$500 damage deposit at time of issuance.
- b) To pay a meter rental fee of \$1,000 per six months (non pro-rated, non refundable).
- c) To take full responsibility for any repairs to damaged City property.
- d) That all repairs will be performed by the City of Golden and billed to the Applicant above.
- e) To call Public Works with a meter reading during each of the date periods listed below:

Quarterly statements will be billed reflecting the above referenced readings and will be subject to Golden Municipal Code Section 13.08.070 regarding payments and late delinquent charges.

**If the Applicant fails to call in the above listed meter with a reading on the said dates, the Applicant will automatically be billed a Standard Load Count of 50,000 gallons with all other fees incurred over the time of issuance or last billing, with no further credit issued when actual reading is obtained.**

2) The Applicant agrees to use the meter at all times when obtaining water to ensure all water that is used is metered and paid for or face penalties up to \$1,000 under Municipal Code 13.08.110.

3) Water may only be drawn from the assigned fire hydrant.

4) **During operation only the auxiliary valve shall be used for volume control. The fire hydrant shall not be throttled but used only in the full open or fully closed position.**

5) The Applicant must comply with all applicable City of Golden and AWWA Water Specifications, including back flow prevention and cross connection standards.

6) City of Golden Fire Department Requirements include:

- a) Hydrant permitted for use shall remain accessible for Fire Department use at all times. A minimum of a three foot clearance shall be maintained.
- b) Water meter is to be removed when not in immediate use (i.e. daily) and hydrant appropriately drained after each use.
